Early Years Frequently Asked Questions 25th March 2020

Do I need to let Ofsted know that I am closing due to Coronovirus?

Ofsted have confirmed that settings and childminders do not need to notify Ofsted if they are closing due to Coronavirus – see guidance document link above

I am a childminder, do I need to put my own children on the data collection form? No, please just put the keyworker/vulnerable children on the form

We have combined with the school provision; school are completing the data form – should we submit data for our own setting children separately?

Yes, please submit your own setting data separately so that children are not counted twice.

Do I need to complete the data form every day even though I have told you I am closed?

Please continue to complete the form every day until further notice

Are you able to write me a letter that asks me to close so that I can claim from my insurance company and protect the future of my setting?

We are unable to answer this at the moment as we are still waiting for advice from the Council's legal team

Will the local authority provide settings with permits for staff to show to the police if they are challenged when travelling to and from work?

At this stage we are advising settings to ensure staff have I.D. badges, a payslip or a permit on the setting's own headed note paper with them when they are travelling for work purposes
