What is this course about?

This course will give you the opportunity to learn how to simply sketch the outlines and then to use pastels to create your own art work.

This course is suitable for both beginners and those with some experience.

Topics will include:

- An introduction to various papers to get the best from pastel drawings
- How to sketch simple outlines as a basis for pastel work
- How to create simple sketches of portraits
- How to create simple sketches of animals
- How to fix finished pastel work and frame them.

How will I learn?

Your tutor will demonstrate the different techniques as you work alongside creating your own pastel art work. One to one support and guidance provided by the tutor.

To enhance your learning we will provide you with an individual learning plan to enable you to record your progress and achievement. This will be yours to keep and will act as your own personal reminder between classes as well as once your course has finished.

What materials will I need?

Materials will be provided for the first week only.

Your tutor will provide advice regarding materials to bring for the following weeks.
