What is this course about?

Oasis covered in Cling Film (Florist) Non Stick Rolling Pin 6in or 9in Ball Tool – PME No 3 Tool Dresden – Jem No 4 Tool Craft Knife – PME No 7 Tool Paint Brushes – Dusting Square ended 6 & 8mm Sable "00" "2" &/or "3" Small Pair of scissors Tweezers (if you have them) Bath Sponge – (supermarket) Non Stick Work Board 6"x5" or 10"X6 3/4" Green or White Cel Sticks pack of 2 - or a piece of wooden dowelling with a pointed end (the size of a pencil) Orchard Pad white (no holes) Empty Shoe Box with tissue in the bottom for Storage.

1. Plunger Blossom Cutters, miniature with ejector, set of 3: PME sizes 1/4 inch, 3/8 inch and 1/2 inch.

3. Carnation, TinkerTech 2: 313 (30mm) medium or set of 3 PME cutters.

4. Freesia, Orchard product cutter (35mm).

5. Sweetpeas, TinkerTech 2: 555/556 (30mm).

6. Daisy, 8 petal pointed 104 (33mm).
