#### What is this course about?

Discover the potential of up-cycling or mending clothing using a sewing machine or hand stitching to add a new lease of life to your wardrobe.

This course is suitable for beginners and those with some experience and in the first session we will be finding out what you already know, exploring basic techniques and discussing future projects.
