





Develop your drawing skills and confidence using a variety of media including pencils and pens (dip pens, fountain pens) charcoal, chalks and crayons. Learners will be encouraged to develop their own style of drawing still life objects, photographs and inspirational items.

You will be introduced to work of artists who have used these techniques in an art historical context to help build a contextual understanding.

This course is suitable for both beginners and those who would like to revisit the basics of drawing.

Topics include:

- Use of light and shade
- Linear & aerial perspective
- Shadow theory
- Discovery of the Golden Section





Introduction to Still Life Drawing

How will I learn?

Tutor demonstrations of drawing techniques will be followed by class participation and discussion. You will practise by creating your own compositions. To enhance your learning we will provide you with an individual learning plan to enable you to record your progress and achievement. This will be yours to keep and will act as your own personal reminder between classes as well as once your course has finished. Learners will be encouraged to keep learning journals and sketch books where ideas and their own artistic practise can be developed and grown.

What materials will I need?*

Materials will be provided for the first week only. Your tutor will provide further advice regarding materials to bring for the following weeks (requirements will depend on your choice of medium/s but it will include:

 A selection of paper, variety of pens, pencils, pastel, inks, charcoal or acrylic paints
