



Introduction to Royal Icing

What is this course about?

Gain the skills and techniques required to decorate a cake using royal icing.

This course is suitable for those who have previous experience/skills within sugar craft, but may be new to royal icing techniques. The course requires you to bring a prepared iced dummy cake in a colour of your choice - please see page two for more details of what you will need to bring with you. 8"x3" round straight edged covered dummy
12" round covered cake drum/board
NB: The dummy and drum/board should both be coated with coloured sugar paste (colour is the choice of the student) a minimum of 48 hours prior to class. The dummy should be mounted onto the board before arriving at class.
12" cake box to take project home in

Round paintbrush approx. SK no. 2 or similar
Small pot for water
A blue Jay cloth or equivalent
