



# Learn to Knit

## What is this course about?

Whether you are a complete beginner or returning to knitting after a long break, this course will teach you all the basics needed to start making knitted items. Learn how to cast on and off, knit, purl, change colours, read simple knitting patterns, and sew knitted pieces together.

## Topics include:

- ◆ Introduction to the basic tools and yarns used in knitting and how to hold the yarn and needles.
- ◆ How to cast on and off and how to do knit and purl stitches.
- ◆ Combine knit and purl stitches to create different stitch patterns such as garter, stocking, moss and ribbed.
- ◆ How to change colour and sew knitted pieces together.

## How will I learn?

Your tutor will be on hand to guide you through the different stitches and techniques used. There will be demonstrations, group tuition and individual support. Guidance and advice will be provided at every stage by our friendly, experienced tutor.

To enhance your learning we will provide you with an individual learning plan to enable you to record your progress and achievement. This will be yours to keep and will act as your own personal reminder between classes as well as once your course has finished.

This course is suitable for absolute beginners who have never knitted before and also for those with a little knitting experience who wish to practice basic skills in a friendly, supportive environment with expert help on hand.

## What materials will I need?

Materials will be supplied for the **first session only**. Additional materials will be required during the course - advice will be given in your first session regarding additional materials.
