What is this course about?

This course will enable you to build on skills previously learnt. Students will work on their own projects producing more complex flowers and foliage and taping together to create large floral sprays or arrangements. This course is suitable for those with previous experience of making flowers and who have worked with sugar paste before.

How will I learn?

You will discover how to use the range of sugar craft tools and materials needed to create a high quality finish. There will be demonstrations, group tuition and individual support. Plenty of tips and advice will be provided in order to achieve the best possible results. To enhance your learning we will provide you with an individual learning plan to enable you to record your progress

and achievement. This will be yours to keep and will act as your own personal reminder between classes as well as once your course has finished.

What materials will I need?

Session 1:

Please bring an apron or an old shirt, a craft knife, a ball tool, sugar craft rolling pin and board (smooth plastic or Formica - not wooden). If you have any other sugar craft tools then please bring these too.

Your tutor will provide information and advice at session 1, providing an explanation of how and when they can be used.

Non Stick Rolling Pin 6in or 9in
Ball Tool – PME No 3 Tool
Dresden – Jem No 4 Tool
Craft Knife – PME No 7 Tool
Paint Brushes – Dusting Square ended 6 & 8mm
Sable “00” “2” &/or “3”
Small Pair of scissors
Tweezers (if you have them)
Bath Sponge – (supermarket)
Non Stick Work Board 6”x5” or 10”X6 3/4” Green or White
Cel Sticks pack of 2 - or a piece of wooden dowelling with a pointed end (the size of a pencil)
Orchard Pad white (no holes)
Empty Shoe Box with tissue in the bottom for storage
