What is this course about?

This course provides an enjoyable way to gain an introduction to the basics of French. You will find out how to use commonly used simple phrases and questions to help you to get by in everyday situations.

This course is suitable for complete beginners without any previous experience of this language.

Topics include:

- ◆ Ordering food and drinks
- ◆ Asking for directions
- ◆ Booking a room in a hotel
- ◆ Shopping
- ◆ Buying tickets for travel

We will focus on practising speaking and listening skills to develop confidence when speaking. You will be working as a group, in pairs and on an individual basis too. Guidance and support will be provided at every stage by our friendly and experienced tutor.
