What is this course about?

In this course, we will focus on conversation with the aim of learners expanding their vocabulary for use in everyday situations in order to express themselves more accurately and confidently in Spanish. There will also be an element of revision included to further embed the topics covered in previous terms.

Topics may include:

- Talking about your favourite film or book and giving opinions.
- Expressing wishes and talking about plans for the future.
- Talking about memories
- Use of different past tenses
- Use of POR/PARA

What previous experience do I need?

This course is suitable for those who have completed 2 years of Spanish at Pound Lane, or who already have an awareness of basic phrases that include: introductions, ordering food, shopping, expressing likes and dislikes, discussing hobbies and interests and giving opinions.

Learners should have some knowledge of how to use Spanish verbs in the present tense, past tense and future tense.

How will I learn?

We will be working as a group, in pairs and on an individual basis too. Support will be provided at every stage by our friendly experienced tutor. Your tutor will provide advice, guidance and support to express yourself in Spanish through games, role play and other activities.

To enhance your learning we will provide you with an individual learning plan to enable you to record your progress and achievement. This will be yours to keep and will act as your own personal reminder between classes as well as once your course has finished.
