Pound Lane Art Programme -Drawing & Painting



General Information

We are now offering a more structured art programme. This information sheet provides an over view of the programme covering a two year period, the length of time you stay with us is entirely up to you! Your tutor will provide advice, guidance and support to enable you to develop your painting skills in practical and friendly workshop sessions.

Materials will be provided for the first week only, you will need to provide your own art materials after this. Requirements will include pencils, paints, brushes, paper, masking tape and a painting board. If you already have some resources please bring them with you.

At the first session your tutor will provide advice regarding materials to bring for the following weeks so please don't worry about this before joining the course

Year One (terms 1- 3) : autumn, spring, summer

Experience the enjoyment of drawing and painting using a variety of materials and techniques. Learning about:

- composition & drawing observational skills
- mark making using pencils a variety of materials
- measuring still life objects composition and content
- colour theory and how to mix colours
- painting techniques
- one-point perspective and drawing negative space

Year Two (terms 4 - 6) : autumn, spring, summer

This three term course is for those that have completed 3 terms of the Drawing & Painting courses at Pound Lane and for those that have some experience of the following:

- Have some understanding of how to create mid tone, light, shadow and texture using pencil mark making techniques
- Have some understanding of how to measure and draw still life objects
- Can mix paint colours using primary colours to create secondary and tertiary colours
- Open to drawing using different media: charcoal, inks, pastels

We will further explore both drawing and painting techniques using a variety of medium such as pencil, pastel, inks, charcoal, acrylics and mixed media. We will also explore the painting styles of well-known artists whilst working towards developing a style of your own.

This second year completes our programme in Drawing & Painting; we have a Developing Artists course for a further academic year (autumn, spring and summer terms). Please speak to your tutor for further information, as there are entry requirements for this course.

If you have not attended any of our art courses you would need to provide: a portfolio of your work, be able to demonstrate the skills and abilities required and have a discussion with one of our art tutors for further information.
