What is this course about?

This course will give you the foundation steps to learn traditional patchwork techniques. You will learn how to plan & produce templates as well as how to join block geometric shapes which can then be quilted and appliqued.

The course will cover contemporary regional patchwork types including Sussex. Learners will produce at least 2 different samples of functional/ decorative needlework.

Topics include:

- ◆ Planning and producing templates
- ◆ Joining block geometric shapes
- ◆ Quilting and applique

What previous experience do I need?

As this is a mixed ability course, no previous experience of patchwork & quilting is needed, however if learners have a basic understanding of sewing then this would be advantageous.

How will I learn?

This is a structured step by step course. Your tutor will provide advice, guidance and support to enable you to gain the necessary

skills for further exploration into patchwork quilting and applique. To enhance your learning we will provide you with an individual learning plan to enable you to record your progress and achievement. This will be yours to keep and will act as your own personal reminder between classes as well as once your course has finished.

What materials will I need?*

You will need a basic sewing kit. Please bring any fabric that you would like to see incorporated into your stitched creations.
