

Next Steps Family History



Following on from our beginner's course, this course will enable you to continue to further develop the skills you need to make your research more successful.

Exploring additional sites and sources of information to further your personal search and hopefully fill in the gaps!

If you have some experience of family history research but have not previously attended our beginner's course please contact us, we will be happy to provide advice regarding course levels.

Please note: This course is not suitable for beginners.

Illustrated tutorials will be used throughout, using overviews and case studies to highlight key points. Guidance, advice and support will be provided at every stage.

Basic computer skills are required, you will need to know how to use a mouse and have experience of using the internet to search for information (e.g. using Google or other search engines).

It will also be useful to bring any documentation or other information relating to your family that you have already discovered.

Please bring a notepad, pen and a brief list of your research goals.

Further course are available to continue your progression:

British Social History - looking at major changes within British history, relating to social and welfare changes and how these provide more opportunities for searching records

Family History workshops - usually in the summer term, we offer a number of 3 hour workshops with specific themes e.g. Ancestry.co.uk, Kill off your Ancestors, Family Tree Maker.
