Improved transport options

Support moving from child to adult services



Improvements in housing and employment options

Life expectancy is 14 years lower for men and 17 years lower for women

More likely to experience **mental health issues**



Large health inequalities

are experienced by people with a Learning Disability in Warwickshire

Higher risk of engaging in **less healthy choices**



More likely to live with **physical health issues**



More likely to have an **avoidable death**



Less likely to get **vaccinated or go for health screening**



To tackle health inequalities and better meet the needs of people with a learning disability we need to....

- **Make reasonable adjustments to ensure people with a learning disability can access services.**
- **Encourage registration on the GP learning disability register.**
- **Promote annual health checks.**
- **Engage with people with a learning disability.**
- **Regularly record and monitor data in our services.**
