Lesson Outline

This 1 hour lesson is designed to make students examine what is special about their local area and how the railways link it to other places to explore as part of the project to name the Nuneaton to Leamington Railway Line.

Learning Objectives

By the end of the lesson, students should be able to:

- Locate their home town/city, school and local attractions on a map
- Identify what makes where they live special to them
- Explore what attractions they can access through the railways
- Begin to understand the environmental benefits of travelling by rail
