Kenilworth Road Leamington Spa

Update: Kenilworth Road Cycle Route, Learnington Spa (K2L Section 1a)

Dear Sir/ Madam

Thank you for your patience during the construction work for the new cycle route along the A452 Kenilworth Road. Phase 1 was largely complete in time for the Coronation weekend at the start of May and the signal controlled pedestrian crossing near Woodcote Road has now been reinstated. Cycle route signs and markings are being installed over the next few weeks. Work is also due to take place shortly to relocate the bus stop near Northumberland Road to accommodate the new crossing refuge island.

We would respectfully ask that residents and their visitors do not park on the pavements and do not obstruct the use of the footway or cycle track.

Phase 2 works are scheduled to restart in the Autumn and continue southwards from Phase 1. Separate advance notice of the planned start date will be provided to affected residents and businesses, and will be signed on street. Phase 2 includes works at the Lillington Avenue junction as well as changes to provide safer crossing facilities across Clarendon Avenue near Beauchamp Road.

During June we plan to advertise Notices/ Traffic Regulation Orders for the following additional measures proposed to be introduced as part of Phase 2:

- Double yellow lines on Kenilworth Road
- Mandatory cycle lane and removal of a pay and display parking bay on Clarendon Avenue
- Short sections of shared use footway/ cycle track on Kenilworth Road, Woodcote Road, Northumberland Road and Cloister Crofts
- Road hump/ priority crossing point on Cloister Crofts
