Name the Line

After over 200 suggestions, 3 shortlisted names and 1100 votes, the public have voted for the Nuneaton - Leamington Line to be named the Elephant & Bear Line. The name refers to the symbols of Coventry and Warwickshire. This is the only railway line that only serves the two areas and the elephant and bear have cultural and historical significance along the line. With the new name, the Heart of England Community Rail Partnership will now work with Local Authority and Train Operating Company partners and more to promote the line and capture the imagination of those who travel on it.

Railway Explorations

Chiltern Railways have awarded us funding through their Community Investment Fund to deliver our Railway Explorations project. Working with newly arrived communities in Solihull and Coventry, this project aims to provide rail confidence building sessions and days out by rail to showcase the many opportunities that are accessible by train.

Rugby Colour Palette

Avanti West Coast have awarded us funding to develop a Rugby Colour Palette. Based on the success of the Leamington and Warwick Colour Palette schemes, we'll be working with artist Stacey Barnfield, Ruby Road Productions and local authority partners to create a Rugby Colour palette based on suggestions from the local community.

Funding Opportunities

CRP Small Grants Fund

Over the past year we have had a dedicated Small Grants Fund for station adopters to apply for. Each station adopter group in the CRP area can apply for up to £175 a year to spend on things like bulbs, tools, CRN membership etc. Up until now there have been 4 application windows for when groups can apply, however we are now changing this so that adoption groups can apply at any time of the year. The £175 will reset at the start of every financial year (April 1st). For more information about the grant, please email us.

Alpkit Foundation

The Alpkit Foundation makes small awards to people, groups and schools that work to remove the barriers in getting outdoors and experience wild places. Warwick District Council - Arts Project Grant

Creative projects are becoming far more common on the railways and Warwick District Council currently have an Arts Project Grant open for bids between $\pm 500 - \pm 2,000$. Well worth looking into for groups wanting to incorporate art into their stations in the district.

Warwickshire County Council - Social Fabric Fund

WCC have launched their <u>Social Fabric Fund</u> to invest in social infrastructure" to develop and strengthen Warwickshire's most deprived communities and, in so doing so, improve residents' life chances and reduce inequalities.
