Advance Notice of Works – Cycle Route (NCN41) Improvements - Proposed Verge Protection – A425 Radford Road, Leamington Spa.

Dear Resident,

Further to my update on progress of works letter of 28th December 2023 in connection with the above project, I am writing to provide an update on the works.

The works to widen and resurface the existing footways / cycleways, resurface the carriageway and install a new Toucan crossing facility have now been completed. New trees have also been planted along Radford Road, and Warwick District Council has completed some hedge-laying.

There are some further works that now need to be planned to protect the existing grass verges in front of the residential properties, as the above works have highlighted a problem of parking on, or driving over, the grass verges along Radford Road. This is resulting in substantial damage to the newly reinstated and topsoiled verges.

We will therefore be installing a number of timber posts along the back of the grass verges to protect these areas.

The works are scheduled to take place within the next 4 weeks. We would kindly request that every effort is made not to park or drive on the verges whilst the works are being done or in the future. Access to residential properties / driveways will be maintained throughout the course of the works.

The works will be undertaken by the County Council's Highways Contractor – Balfour Beatty Living Places. If you have any queries or concerns over the works while they are being carried out, please contact the Duty Manager on 03452 415302.
