**PROPOSED ROAD HUMPS (PRIORITY CROSSING FOR PEDESTRIANS AND CYCLISTS)
ON WOODLAND ROAD, CRACKLEY, KENILWORTH**

Warwickshire County Council proposes to construct a road hump on Woodland Road at the junction with the A429 Coventry Road, Crackley, Kenilworth (as described with approximate measurements in the Schedule below) pursuant to the Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980.
