**A426 LEICESTER ROAD, RUGBY - PROPOSED CONVERSION OF FOOTWAY TO
SHARED USE FOOTWAY / CYCLE TRACK**

Warwickshire County Council propose, pursuant to sections 65 and 66 of the Highways Act 1980, to convert that part of the existing footway on the A426 Leicester Road, Rugby which is described in the Schedule below, into a shared use footway/cycle track.

SCHEDULE

A426 Leicester Road, Rugby

1. Approximately 80 metres of footway on the eastern side of A426 Leicester Road / Boughton Road between the existing Toucan crossing on Boughton Road and a planned new Toucan crossing on the A426 Leicester Road to the north of the A426 Leicester Road / Boughton Road roundabout.
2. Approximately 10 metres of footway on the western side of the A426 Leicester Road at the eastern end of the closed off spur of Brownsover Lane.
