**A429 STRATFORD ROAD AND SHAKESPEARE AVENUE, WARWICK -
PROPOSED CONVERSION OF FOOTWAY TO SHARED USE FOOTWAY /
CYCLE TRACK**

1. STATEMENT OF REASONS

- 1.1** Warwickshire County Council is proposing, pursuant to sections 65 and 66 of the Highways Act 1980, to convert parts of existing footways on the A429 Stratford Road and Shakespeare Avenue (as described in the Schedule below) into a shared use footway/cycle track for use by pedestrians and cyclists.
- 1.2** The shared use footway/cycle track is being introduced to provide a connection between the existing cycle routes on the A429 Stratford Road and A4189 Hampton Road.
- 1.3** The scheme will involve widening approximately 760 metres of existing footways on Stratford Road and Shakespeare Avenue into the adjacent highway verge to a minimum width of 3 metres to allow conversion to shared use footways / cycle tracks, as detailed on drawing numbers 9.2-A429-064-003 and 9.2-A429-064-005.

SCHEDULE

A429 Stratford Road

1. Approximately 300 metres of footway on the eastern side of the A429 Stratford Road, from the end of the existing shared use footway / cycleway near the entrance to Leafield Cottages to the existing pedestrian crossing near Shakespeare Avenue.
2. Approximately 40 metres of footway on the western side of the A429 Stratford Road between the pedestrian crossing and the junction with Shakespeare Avenue.

Shakespeare Avenue

Approximately 420 metres of footway on the southern side of Shakespeare Avenue between A429 Stratford Road and the service road on A4189 Hampton Road.
