


**Information for the public relating to the permissive rights granted to cyclists over the footpath between Farmer Ward Road and Clarkes Avenue.**

There is a footpath that runs between Farmer Ward Road (point A) and Clarkes Avenue (point B), see map below, that the Council as the landowner wishes to grant permissive rights to cyclists over.



The length of footpath is 100 metres between points A and B.

The Council will undertake the following works to allow for cyclists and pedestrians to use the footpath.

1. To erect notices at either end of the footpath which state;  
“This route is a permissive path for use by pedestrians and cyclists only”.
2. To erect appropriate signs, according to the Traffic Signs and General Directions 2016, which show that the route is for shared use by cyclists and pedestrians.
3. To widen the path and resurface to 3.0metres.
4. To remove barriers near Clarkes Avenue and Farmer Ward Road.
5. To provide dropped kerbs and tactile paving at Clarkes Avenue and Farmer Ward Road.
