Key questions

- What is the family's understanding of what is happening next?
- What is the multi-agency approach?
- What is the focus for the child and family?
- What are the recommendations following the referral/ concerns that were raised?
- Who are the professionals working with the family?

Through **raising our awareness** that 'Child abuse happens in Warwickshire' and applying our knowledge through effective early intervention we can safely hold risk with a shared responsibility in a multi-agency approach whilst working collaboratively with children and families.
