# Lead professional support guide

On contact from the Front Door or a locality network team member please consider a restorative conversation with the professional to feel confident in how to work with families and ensure we

understand the voice of the child.

To support you in this please reflect on the following questions.

**Key questions** 

- What is the family's understanding of what is happening next?
- O What is the multi-agency approach?
- o What is the focus for the child and family?
- o What are the recommendations following the referral/ concerns that were raised?
- o Who are the professionals working with the family?

Through raising our awareness that 'Child abuse happens in Warwickshire' and applying our knowledge through effective early intervention we can safely hold risk with a shared responsibility in a multi-agency approach whilst working collaboratively with children and families.
