



What is Lifelong Links?

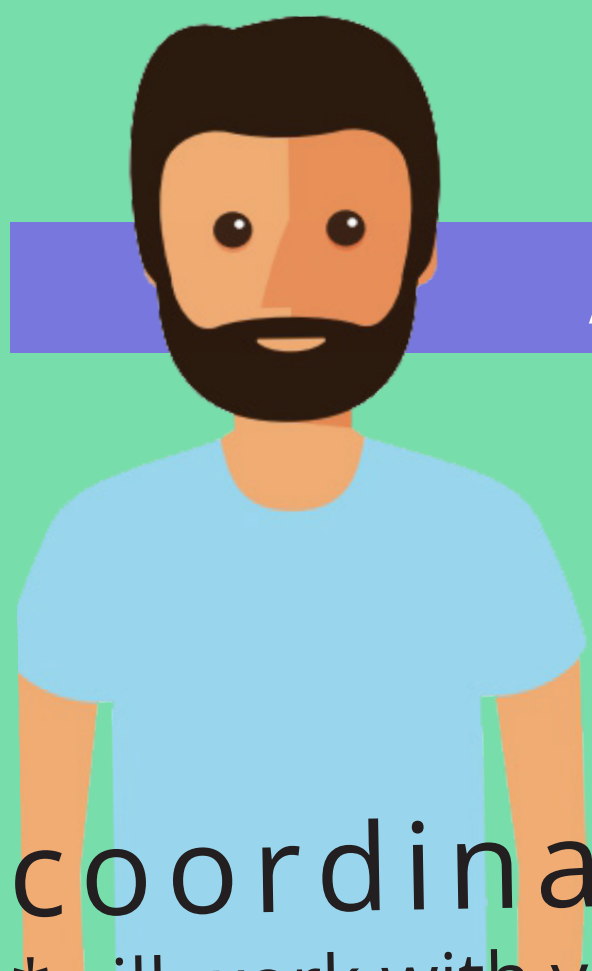


It can help find and bring together people who care about you.

After chatting to you the coordinator will:

Learn about the people that are important to you.

See if they can find those people and get in contact with them, if it is safe to do so.

3

Discuss with you and your social worker if they should be invited to a meeting called a **Family Group Conference**.

You can learn more about your family history.

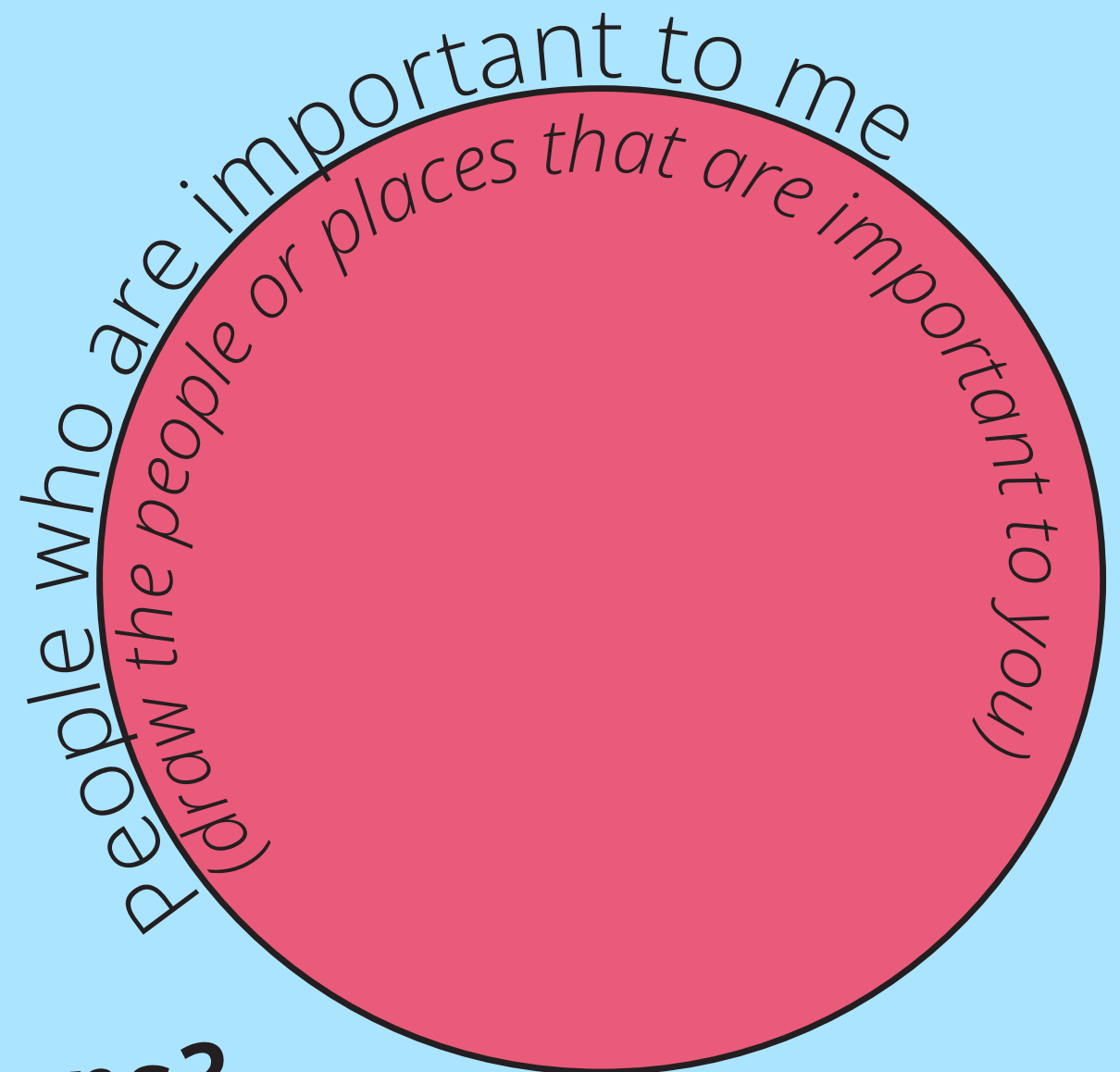


By bringing together people who you want in your life and who you can turn to for support as you grow up.
