The service offers:

A Family Network Meeting (FNM) is a family led meeting where a young person's family and friends come together to make a plan to support them.

Mediation is a confidential, short process where a neutral third party assists two disputing parties to resolve conflict around child focused issues.

Parenting Apart is a bespoke 4-5 week program for conflicted separated parents to develop healthy co-parenting and positive child relationships. Lifelong Links is for young people in care and those with care experience under 25 years old. The service helps them rebuild and maintain connections with important people in their lives, ensuring they remain fully supported into adulthood.
