

Public Transport Options for school and college August 2025

Route options

- Have a look at our <u>public transport maps</u> online to see which bus routed so to, or near, the school, and your home address. Once you finds a suitable route, check the <u>timetable</u> to make sure it travels at the right time https://apps.warwickshire.gov.uk/BusTimetable/
- Use our timetable finder to find the buses that travel through your town or village
- Use <u>Traveline</u> to plan your route. This is useful if you think you might have to change bus, but it does not include any extra school buses unless they are part of a normal bus route.
- Check with your school or college to find out if there are any private school buses you could use.

Ticket options

The timetable finder will tell you who runs the bus service. There are no tickets which will allow travel on all the bus operators in Warwickshire.

Some of the bus operators offer tickets that last a week or longer, and this is normally cheaper than paying the fare each day. You can normally buy a ticket for a Youndg Person (under 18) which is less than the adult ticket.

Larger bus operators will have an App so you can have your ticket on a phone.

Stagecoach	MegaRider 7 day or 28 day	These are available for the main towns and cover some surrounding areas e.g. Nuneaton also covers North Warwickshire, Leamington & Warwick also allows travel to Kenilworth. MegaRider area tickets will normally be cheaper than the StudyRider Gold.
	StudyRider Gold	Covers the whole Stagecoach Midlands area for the academic year, so you can travel in Northamptonshire & Coventry too. If you are travelling short distances there are likely to be cheaper options.
<u>Arriva</u>	4 week ticket is available	For unlimited travel within the Coventry-Nuneaton area Child fares are available for Under 16s
National Express West Midlands	4 week NX Outer Zones ticket is available	To travel through Warwickshire you will need either the NX Outer Zones or NX OuterZones Rugby ticket. Zone maps are available here NX Operating Zones Tickets also allow travel in the nbus Zone Birmingham, Coventry etc.
