












Testing messaging

Testing with symptoms

<p>Anyone can get #COVID19 and anyone can spread it. If you are displaying these symptoms High temperature or New, continuous cough or Loss of sense of smell or taste</p> <p>you must self-isolate immediately and get a test nhs.uk/coronavirus or call 119</p>	 <p>let's do the right thing for Warwickshire</p> <p>Get a test if you have any COVID-19 symptoms</p> <p>Stay at home ▶ Protect the NHS ▶ Save lives</p>
<p>To help us move along the roadmap out of lockdown it's important that we all take steps to reduce the spread of COVID-19.</p> <p>If you are displaying any symptoms of COVID-19 then you must self-isolate and get a test. Testing with no symptoms

<p>Community testing helps to identify positive cases of COVID-19 in people who do not have any symptoms. It is recommended that you get tested twice a week at a community test site.</p> <p>To find out more visit: www.warwickshire.gov.uk/covidtesting</p>	 <p>If you cannot work from home we encourage you to regularly get a COVID-19 test.</p> <p>Book here now</p>
<p>Did you know that around 1 in 3 people with COVID-19 do not have symptoms and can still infect others!</p> <p>Testing for individuals with no symptoms of #COVID19 is available at locations around the county. Testing in this way helps us to test, trace and isolate the spread of the virus within our communities.</p> <p>To book your slot, visit [link]</p>	 <p>Even with no symptoms you can still get a COVID-19 test.</p> <p>Book here now</p>

<p>Whether you're working, have school age children in your household or bubble or just want peace of mind you can get regular symptom-free tests at our community testing sites. We recommend testing twice a week.</p> <p>www.warwickshire.gov.uk/covidcommunitytesting</p>	
<p>Get tested regularly to help get back to business. If you're working you need a community test twice a week to make sure you are not taking COVID-19 to work with you. 1 in 3 people with COVID-19 don't know they have it and could be putting others in danger. Book a test at www.warwickshire.gov.uk/covidtesting</p>	
<p>If you get a positive COVID-19 test at a community testing site, you will need to get a confirmatory NHS test within 72 hours. To book this visit gov.uk/coronavirus or call 119.</p>	
<p>I get tested twice a week because I go out to work. If you're working or spending time with people outside your household, book a regular community test here www.warwickshire.gov.uk/covidtesting</p>	
<p>I get regularly tested for peace of mind and to protect my vulnerable mother. Testing is quick, free and it saves lives. Book your test at www.warwickshire.gov.uk/covidtesting</p>	
<p>I'm heading back to university and getting tested before I leave to keep my friends and the people I live with safe. To book your test visit www.warwickshire.gov.uk/covidtesting</p>
