Three interlinked pillars of 'sustainability'.


Economic – prosperity, growth, investment.

Environmental – natural resource use, externality, biodiversity.




Population by age

% population that consider their health to be "bad" or "very bad" (5)





- Less likely to reach higher levels of educational attainment.
- More likely to earn less in their lifetimes.
- More likely to need their local council to support them.
- More likely to experience worse health.
- More likely to live shorter lives.

....than the Warwickshire and national averages.

Climate change

- Recognised challenge, but out shadowed by inequality.
- Limited financial resources NBBC's biggest capacity is to influence sustainability is the economic and social dimensions – improving resident's lives.
