### Warwickshire ESOL Provision by area – March 2023

#### Hong Kong British Nationals (Overseas) External Edit

This is an overview of ESOL provision that can be accessed by Homes for Ukraine families across Warwickshire. This includes:

- Mainstream Further Education provision leading to qualifications
- Community provision
- Family Learning Service –ESOL and Family Learning classes
- Migration Services team provision

**Please be aware that Hong Kong British Nationals (Overseas) passport holders are not eligible for the Adult Education Budget. Access to mainstream, accredited courses is via separate funding from the Department for Levelling Up, Housing and Communities, up to a maximum of £850 per financial year.**

**A learner can only be enrolled on one mainstream, accredited course. This means they cannot register for classes with both Adult & Community Learning and a college. This restriction does not apply to community provision.**
