Getting there

Compton Verney is situated 9 miles east of Stratford-upon-Avon on the **B4086 between Wellesbourne and Kineton** and is 6 miles drive from the M40, Junction 12.

Follow the brown signs marked for Compton Verney.

Getting there

There are two entrances to Compton Verney. Please use the **Main Entrance** off the B4086 where you will find the **Welcome Centre**.

At the Welcome Centre you will be greeted by Maddie.

This is the main entrance which is located to the side of the courtyard. You can access this by the steps or by the ramp.

Shuttle bus



From the **Welcome Centre** you can:

- take a short walk up to the main building or catch the fully accessible shuttle bus if it's running
- if the shuttle bus isn't running and you're not able to walk, you can drive up in the car to be dropped off outside the main gallery. The car will need to be returned to the car park for the event.



There are male, female and accessible toilets.




Naple's Gallery

The Naple's Gallery has paintings from the Neapolitan era (1600 to 1800). So some of the artwork in here is over 400 years old.


Adam's Hall

The room has high ceilings so the sound can be a bit echoey. You could bring noise cancellation headphones if you like.




Adam's Hall

Break out area & refreshments

This is the room where you can come for a break if things get a bit noisy in the main hall.

You can also have a drink in here and watch some videos of other supported interns.



Other useful information



Eating and drinking is not allowed in the art gallery spaces (Adam's Hall and Naples Gallery). You can go to the Break Out Area to have a drink and bite to eat.



You will need to be careful and not touch the artwork as it is hundreds of years old and very precious.



If you are sensitive to noise you may want to bring noise cancellation headphones.
