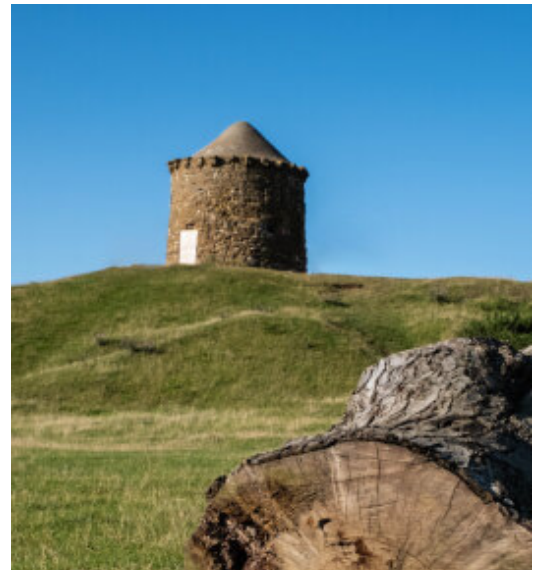

Starting your child's education journey

Warwickshire County Council Admissions will ensure all children living in Warwickshire have a school place. School is one of the most important parts of your child's life, and there is a lot to consider when deciding which school you'd like them to go to. As well as giving them a place to learn, school helps them to grow and prepare for adult life, and also provides a safe place for them to spend time with friends under the supervision of trusted adults.

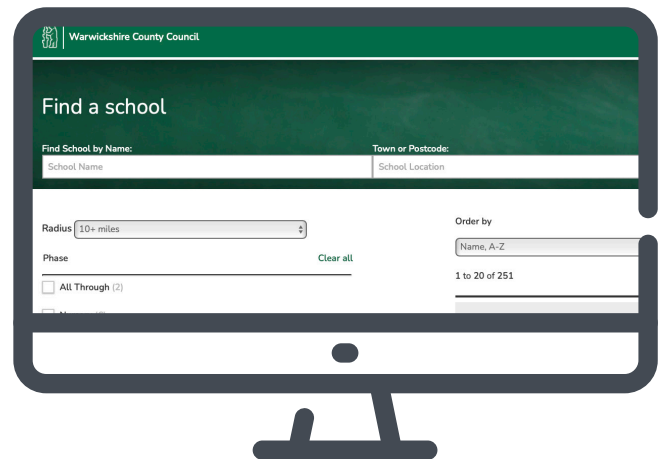

All children in the UK have to be educated and this is available for free in our Warwickshire family of schools.

Children must be in education between 5 and 16 years old. Between 16 and 18, young people must be in education or training.

Applying for a School Place

Our Admissions Team are here to help, so as soon as you arrive in Warwickshire, you should apply for a school place.

Please apply online using our parent portal. It is quick and easy to use and there are also instructions to guide you through the application. You will need to create an account if you don't already have one, provide the details of your child and then select which school(s) you would like to apply for.

You can apply for up to six schools at any time.

If a school is full, you will be notified - we call this a refusal.

You can appeal this decision!

This can often be the case if you are applying for a school place outside of the usual point of entry (i.e. Reception or Year 7). But if we can't provide a place at any of your preference schools, then we will provide you with a place at the nearest school with a vacancy.

You must tell us if you want to accept the place we offer you within 5 working days

Once you accept your new school place, get in touch with the school to arrange a start date and find out all the important information.

Your child must be ready to start their new school within 20 school days.
