What do you love? Let's find your fit!

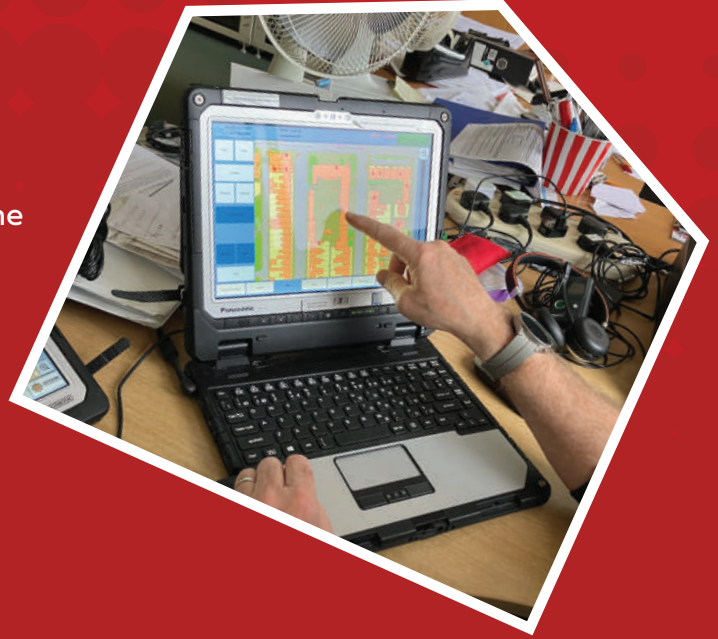
If you're into computers, systems, or technology:

Role: Fire Prevention Officer

- Run workshops, school programs and safety campaigns.

Why it's great: Make a real difference by preventing accidents and saving lives.



If you're calm under pressure and love a challenge:

Role: Firefighter (Control)

- Answer 999 calls, provide reassurance and coordinate emergency responses.
- Use your quick thinking and communication skills to save lives.

Skills you'll use: Multitasking, decision-making and resilience.

Why it's great: Be the vital link between those in need and fire crews.



If you want to save lives on the front line:

Role: Firefighter (wholetime or on-call)

- Respond to emergencies, rescue people and protect your community.
- Take on varied challenges from fires to floods and road traffic collisions.

Skills you'll use: Teamwork, adaptability and physical fitness.

Why it's great: Be a hero in your community and a role model for others.



If you're great at organising and want to support the team:

Role: Business Administrative Support

- Provide key administrative support to different teams and fire crews ensuring smooth operations.
- Handle tasks such as scheduling, document management and resource coordination.

Skills you'll use: Organisation, communication and multitasking.

Why it's great: Help WFRS operate efficiently and keep the team on track!



If you care about supporting people's health and wellbeing:

Role: Occupational Health Officer

- Promote the physical and mental health of firefighters and staff.
- Conduct health assessments and provide support services to keep teams fit for duty.

Skills you'll use: Communication, empathy and knowledge of health practices.

Why it's great: Support the wellbeing of those who work hard to protect others.
