

## Breakdown of offers for Reception and Junior entry to Warwickshire Schools in September 2021

*Data correct as at 14<sup>th</sup> April 2021 but subject to change*

A school might receive more applications than the number of places available (the Published Admission Number or PAN). When this happens, applicants are allocated an over-subscription criterion, then ranked in the order of that criteria. Places are then offered from the top of the ranked list down, until all available places at the school are filled.

Warwickshire maintained schools use the over-subscription criteria identified below, as outlined in Warwickshire County Council's Admission Arrangements for the 2021 entry year.

Schools that are their own admission authority – such as Academies and Voluntary Aided schools – will have their own set of over-subscription criteria, as outlined in their individual 2021 entry admission arrangements.

Only **on time** applications have been processed for places offered on 16<sup>th</sup> April 2021. Late applications, and subsequent changes to applications, will be processed through the reallocation rounds, which will start from **26th April 2021**.

### Warwickshire's 2021 entry over-subscription criteria for maintained PRIMARY schools

The following criteria have been used where schools have received more applications than there are places available, after children with an EHC Plan have been admitted first.

- 1a. Children in the care of, or provided with accommodation by, a local authority within England, and children who were looked after, but ceased to be so because they were adopted (or became subject to a child arrangement order or special guardianship order);
- 1b. Children who have been adopted, either through a local authority or through a voluntary adoption agency that is registered with CVAA UK. This category applies to all adoptions which do not fit within Category 1a, including those which take place outside of English law;
2. Children who are in receipt of the Early Years Pupil Premium, with no more than 14%\* of the places available to be allocated under this category.
3. Children who are subject to a Child in Need Plan or a Child Protection Plan at the time of making the application, or who have been at any point since 1 September 2015, with no more than 9% of the places available to be allocated under this category;
4. Children living in the priority area for the school, who will have a sibling attending the same school in Years 1 - 6 at the time of admission in September 2021;
5. Other children living in the priority area for the school;
6. Children living outside the priority area for the school, who will have a sibling attending the same school in Years 1 – 6 at the time of admission in September 2021; 7. Other children living outside the priority area for the school.
7. Other children living outside the priority area for the school.

**Warwickshire's 2021 entry over-subscription criteria for maintained  
INFANT schools**

The following criteria have been used where schools have received more applications than there are places available, after children with an EHC Plan have been admitted first.

- 1a. Children in the care of, or provided with accommodation by, a local authority within England, and children who were looked after, but ceased to be so because they were adopted (or became subject to a child arrangement order or special guardianship order);
- 1b. Children who have been adopted, either through a local authority or through a voluntary adoption agency that is registered with CVAA UK. This category applies to all adoptions which do not fit within Category 1a, including those which take place outside of English law;
2. Children who are in receipt of the Early Years Pupil Premium, with no more than 14%\* of the places available to be allocated under this category.
3. Children who are subject to a Child in Need Plan or a Child Protection Plan at the time of making the application, or who have been at any point since 1 September 2015, with no more than 9% of the places available to be allocated under this category;
- 4a. Children living in the priority area for the school, who will have a sibling attending the same school in Year 1 or 2 at the time of admission in September 2021;
- 4b. Children living in the priority area for the school, who will have a sibling attending the partner junior school in Years 3 - 6 at the time of admission in September 2021;
5. Other children living in the priority area for the school;
- 6a. Children living outside the priority area for the school, who will have a sibling attending the same school in Year 1 or 2 at the time of admission in September 2021;
- 6b. Children living outside the priority area for the school, who will have a sibling attending the partner junior school in Years 3 - 6 at the time of admission in September 2021;
7. Other children living outside the priority area for the school.

*If you are also applying for a Year 3 place at the partner junior school for another child, for entry in September 2021, please be aware that they will not be considered as a sibling link for the infant school applicant until after that child has been offered a place at the junior school and you have confirmed your acceptance of the Year 3 place.*

## Warwickshire's 2021 entry over-subscription criteria for maintained JUNIOR schools

The following criteria have been used where schools have received more applications than there are places available, after children with an EHC Plan have been admitted first.

- 1a. Children in the care of, or provided with accommodation by, a local authority within England, and children who were looked after, but ceased to be so because they were adopted (or became subject to a child arrangement order or special guardianship order);
- 1b. Children who have been adopted, either through a local authority or through a voluntary adoption agency that is registered with CVAA UK. This category applies to all adoptions which do not fit within Category 1a, including those which take place outside of English law;
2. Children who are in receipt of the Early Years Pupil Premium, with no more than 14%\* of the places available to be allocated under this category.
3. Children who are subject to a Child in Need Plan or a Child Protection Plan at the time of making the application, or who have been at any point since 1 September 2015, with no more than 9% of the places available to be allocated under this category;
4. Children who currently attend the partner infant school\* and who intend to remain at that school until the end of the 2021/22 academic year in July 2021;
- 5a. Children living in the priority area for the school, who will have a sibling attending the same school in Years 4, 5 or 6 at the time of admission in September 2021;
- 5b. Children living in the priority area for the school, who will have a sibling attending the partner infant school at the time of admission in September 2021;
6. Other children living in the priority area for the school;
- 7a. Children living outside the priority area for the school, who will have a sibling attending the same school in Years 4, 5 or 6 at the time of admission in September 2021;
- 7b. Children living outside the priority area for the school, who will have a sibling attending the partner infant school at the time of admission in September 2021;
8. Other children living outside the priority area for the school.

*If you are also applying for a Reception place at the partner infant school for another child, for entry in September 2021, please be aware that they will not be considered as a sibling link for the junior school applicant until after that child has been offered a place at the infant school and you have confirmed your acceptance of the Reception place.*

## **Over-subscription Categories – Further Notes**

In relation all the above over-subscription categories:

- Children with a Statement of Special Educational Needs or an Education, Health and Care (EHC) Plan that names a school will be admitted first. In this event the number of places that remain for allocation will be reduced.
- Children attending, or with a place at, a nursery class do not have a higher priority for - and are not guaranteed - a place at the attached primary school.
- Time of admission relates to the time the applicant would start at the school – not the time of application or offer.

Additionally, within each of the above criteria, priority is given in order of straight-line distance between the home address and school. The shortest distance has the highest priority. Distance has been calculated by the straight-line measurement from the applicant's home address to the centre point ("centroid") of the preferred school (all measurements are subject changes that may occur as a result of updated mapping data). This applies equally to those living inside and outside the County's boundary. A school's priority area is as defined on the Warwickshire Admissions website:

## **Offer Day Data**

Also provided is the number of places available at each school, for this year of entry, and confirmation of the criterion of the last offer made. Please note: this information is subject to change.

Also shown is data relating to the number of offers available, and made, in relation to Warwickshire maintained schools that have utilised the specific over-subscription criteria relating to applicants in receipt of – or under – one of the following; Early Years' Pupil Premium (EYPP), Pupil Premium (PP), a Child in Need Plan (CIN) and a Child Protection Plan (CP).

If you have named a school outside of Warwickshire on your application, you will need to contact the relevant Local Authority of that school to discuss the outcome of your application for that school further.

Note: Rows that are white signify Warwickshire maintained schools, meaning that the local authority is the admission authority for the school. Rows in blue signify a school that is its own admission authority, for example, an academy or a voluntary aided school.
