Determine Admissions Arrangements

Race Leys Junior School for the Academic Year 2026/2027

- 1. Children reach junior school age at the start of the term following their seventh birthday.
- 2. Families will need to complete the Warwickshire admissions application form. For further information and an application form please contact www.warwickshire.gov.uk/contactusschooladmissions.or.call.01926.414143
- 3. The Published Admission Number for Race Leys is 64.

Oversubscription Criteria

Following receipt of families preferences, places will be offered to those children with statements of Special Educational Needs where Race Leys is named. Then, if the number of requests received via the coordinated scheme is more than the number of places available, places will be allocated in the following priority order:

Criterion 1a: Looked after children and all previously looked after children;

Criterion 1b: Children who have been adopted through a CVAA UK agency;

Criterion 2: Children who receive the Pupil Premium, or Service Premium, through their current school, or who have done so at any point since starting school in Reception;

Criterion 3: Children who are currently, or have been at any point since 1st September 2015, subject to a Child in Need Plan or a Child Protection Plan

Criterion 4: Children who currently attend the partner infant school and who intend to remain at that school until the end of the 2021/2020 academic year in July 2022;

Criterion 5: Children living in the priority area for the school, who will have a sibling attending the same school in Years 4, 5 or 6 at the time of admission in September 2022;

Criterion 6: Children living in the priority area for the school, who will have a sibling attending the partner infant school at the time of admission in September 2022*;

Criterion 7: Other children living in the priority area for the school;

Criterion 7a: Children living outside the priority area for the school, who will have a sibling attending the same school in Years 4, 5 or 6 at the time of admission in September 2022;

Criterion 7b: Children living outside the priority area for the school, who will have a sibling attending the partner infant school at the time of admission in September 2022*;

Criterion 8: Other children living outside the priority area for the school.

In cases of over subscription, families can ask for the children's names to be placed on a waiting list held by Warwickshire Admissions.

Appeals

Families have the right to appeal if a place is not offered to the child. Appeals will be handed in line with the Warwickshire Admissions Appeals Code. Families wishing to appeal should do so direct to Warwickshire Admissions.
