<p><b>Section 17</b> Child in Need (CiN) Allocated a social worker</p> <p><b>Section 47</b> Child Protection (CP) Allocated a social worker</p> <p><b>Ever 6 CWSW</b> Had an open case of CiN or CP at any point in the last 6 years (NOT the same as PP Ever 6)</p>	<p><b>Section 20</b> Child Looked After (CLA) Known as Child in Care (CiC) in Warwickshire &amp; Looked After Child (LAC) by DfE</p> <p>Parental Responsibility (PR) remains with parent / guardian</p> <p><b>Section 44 &amp; 46</b> Emergency Care Order Usually when police protection is required</p> <p><b>Section 38</b> Interim Care Order PR given to Local Authority (LA)</p> <p><b>Section 31</b> Full Care Order PR given to LA</p>	<p>Have been in the care of a local authority in England or Wales or from 'state care' outside of England / Wales, but are no longer due to:</p> <p><b>Special Guardianship Order (SGO)</b> Guardian has PR following an order made by the family court. Child lives permanently with the guardian.</p> <p><b>Child Arrangement Order (CAO)</b> Granted by a family court who determine who a child can live with and/or stay with and for how long.</p> <p><b>Adoption Order</b></p>	<p>Have <u>not</u> been in the care of a local authority &amp; no longer live with birth parent/s, under one of the following orders:</p> <p><b>Special Guardianship Order (SGO)</b> Guardian has PR following an order made by the family court. Child lives permanently with the guardian.</p> <p><b>Child Arrangement Order (CAO)</b> Granted by a family court who determine who a child can live with and/or stay with and for how long.</p> <p><b>Adoption Order</b></p>
