




Warwickshire Virtual School Enrichment Newsletter

The programme is available for **children ages 8- 16yrs** who meet at least one of the following:

- Children who are looked after or previously looked after
- Children from low-income families (Free school meals)
- Special Educational Need concern or diagnosis
- Vulnerable at home or in the community

They deliver in mainstream schools, nonmainstream, and out of education
