EXPERIENCE WARWICK PARTNERSHIP PROGRAMME WITH WARWICK UNIVERSITY

A multi-year programme designed to raise aspirations and support progression for pupils in Coventry and Warwickshire:

Year 6/7: Reading Programme

Weekly one-to-one sessions with trained student ambassadors to boost reading skills and self-esteem.

Year 7: Campus Introduction

Pupils explore Warwick's campus and take part in a challenge activity to kickstart their journey.

Year 8: Academic Taster Days

Interactive sessions in Arts, Humanities, Social Sciences, and STEM to broaden subject awareness.

Year 9: Big Idea Workshop

Delivered by Talent Foundry, focusing on social issues, tech for good, and key employability skills.

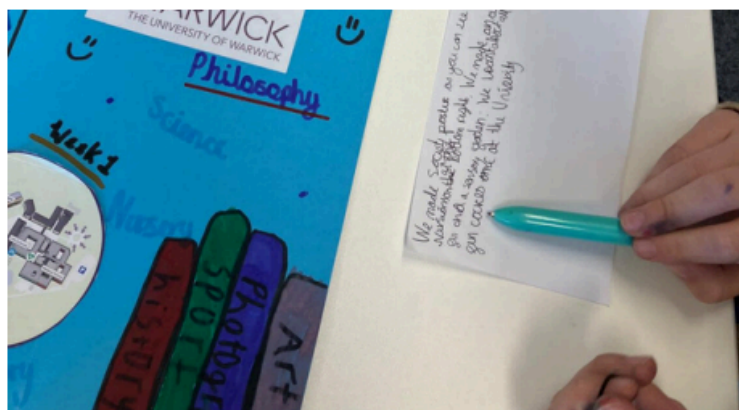
UNIVERSITY EXPLORERS

CHILDREN IN LOCAL AUTHORITY CARE

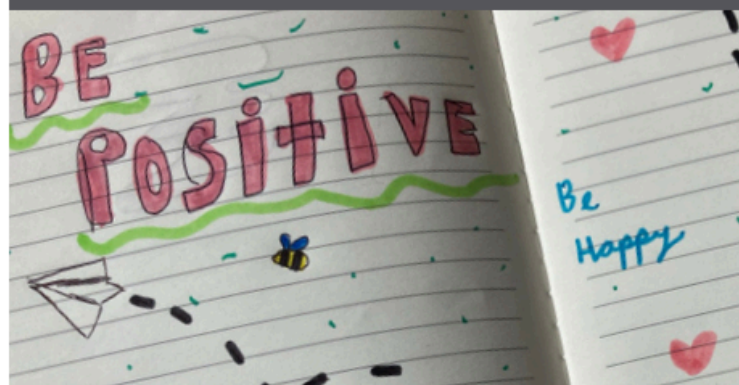


About University Explorers

University Explorers aims to support the educational progression of children in care, to help them develop a peer network, build confidence and resilience and empower them to recognise their potential. By targeting looked after children in Year 6, the project is also well-placed to support children with transition to secondary school.



University Explorers introduces care-experienced pupils to Higher Education through a varied programme of enjoyable and educational activities. The programme is a collaboration between The University of Warwick and the Virtual Schools in Coventry, Warwickshire and Solihull.



Dates for 2026

This is a multi-day programme which takes place on campus at the University of Warwick. Participants attend all four days from 10:00 to 14:30. The programme concludes with a celebration with families. It is free of charge to attend.

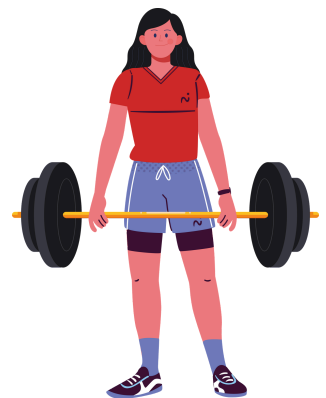
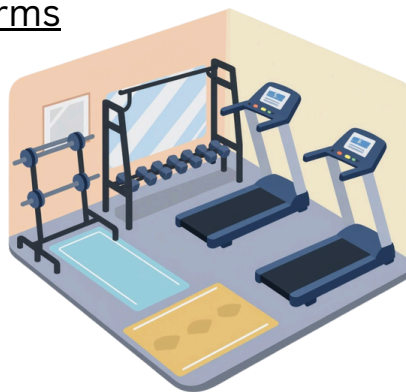
