**PROPOSED TOUCAN CROSSING**

**DENCE DRIVE near LEYES LANE, KENILWORTH.**

Warwickshire County Council hereby gives notice of its intention to install a Toucan crossing on Dencer Drive near Leyes Lane, Kenilworth rather than the initially advertised scheme in January 2023 which was a Traffic Signal Junction with Pedestrian and Cycle Crossing Facilities on Leyes Lane/ Dencer Drive junction, the alternative scheme is being proposed to address some of the concerns raised by local residents regarding the traffic signal junction proposal.

The feedback from this proposal will determine whether a traffic signal junction or a Toucan crossing will be provided at this location to satisfy the planning condition for the development of the Kenilworth Multi Academy Trust "Kenilworth School and Sixth Form" (Warwick District Council Planning Application reference is W/19/0655).
