



St George's Way eastern approach to Bermuda Bridge

Subject to further inspection the contractor has completed the minor remedial works in St George's Way and is preparing to commence remedial works on the gabion wall by Bermuda Parkway Station in January 2024 and prepare the route to install new road surfacing and road markings.

Eastern embankment approach to Bermuda Bridge

The footways on Bermuda Bridge have been completed and opened for the use of pedestrians and cyclists since end of October 2023. The contractor is planning to resurface the eastern approach following completion of the works on St George's Way & Barling Way footway so the route can be opened to traffic without any ongoing roadworks.



Bermuda Bridge Works

The contractor is planning to resurface the bridge following completion of the works on St George's Way so the route can be opened to traffic without any ongoing roadworks.



The contractor is planning to resurface the western bridge approach following completion of the works on St George's Way and Barling Way footway so the route can be opened to traffic without any ongoing roadworks.





Barling Way and The Bridleway

STW have completed works on their existing apparatus to extend up to new footway levels to enable the footway in Barling Way to be completed. The contractor is planning to dewater the area which is currently saturated due to a water leak to commence works on The Barling Way footway.





Gulley Works by Knights Road

Due to standing water near The Bridleway and Knights Road junction the contractor installed new road gulley to minimise the risk to road users due to the cold weather.



CADENT works along Bermuda Road

CADENT have installed a new gas governor by Phoenix Centre and backfilled the excavation and are continuing with a new gas main along Bermuda Road to connect to the gas governor to the existing gas main by Hazel Way. These works are planned to be completed in January 2024.
