**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATIONS ACT 1984 – SECTION 23**

**PROPOSED VARIOUS HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT WORKS**

**A3400 BIRMINGHAM ROAD, STRATFORD-UPON-AVON.**

Warwickshire County Council hereby gives notice of its intention to action the listed highway improvement works to promote active travel and minimise congestion along Birmingham Road.

1. Decommission the existing Puffin crossing on Birmingham Rd near Park Road.
2. Install a Toucan crossing on Birmingham Rd near Maybrook Road.
3. At the traffic signal junction of Birmingham Rd / Hamlet Way the removal of the existing pedestrian facility on the east-west arm of Birmingham Road.
4. Decommission the existing traffic signal junction on Birmingham Rd / Western Road.
5. Install a Parallel crossing on Western Road near Birmingham Road.
