

## A3400 Birmingham Road, Stratford upon Avon

Progress Update 05 August 2025

## Completed - Phases 1 & 2

The two project phases have delivered notable enhancements to local infrastructure. These improvements focus on better drainage, safer and more accessible road crossings, and upgraded facilities for pedestrians and cyclists. Key sections include:

- Phase 1: From Windsor Street to Arden Street was completed in January 2022.
- Phase 2: From Bishopton Roundabout to The Avenue, was completed in February 2025.

A3400 Birmingham Road carriageway resurfacing and road marking works from Bishopton Roundabout to St Peters Way has been completed and the next phase of road surfacing between St Peters Way and Hamlet Way commenced on Monday 04-Aug-2025.

Justin's Avenue road closure has been lifted on the 31<sup>st</sup> July 2025 the new raised crossing will be constructed during resurfacing of the carriageway week commencing 4<sup>th</sup> August.

Work is continuing to upgrade the inbound footway from Hamlet Way to Park Road Roundabout.

The central island at the Hamlet Way junction has been demolished and temporary traffic signals have been installed at Hamlet Way awaiting installation and commissioning of the new traffic signals.

Work has also commenced on the inbound footway immediately north of Regal Road Roundabout, where new pedestrian crossing signals will be installed. The existing footway surfacing and full height kerbs have been removed for new surfacing and drop kerbs for the pedestrian crossing.

Birmingham Road is closed to traffic from 8pm until 6am and access is allowed to residents when safe to do so.
