

A3400 Birmingham Road, Stratford upon Avon

Progress Update 02 September 2025

Completed - Phases 1 & 2

The two project phases have delivered notable enhancements to local infrastructure. These improvements focus on better drainage, safer and more accessible road crossings, and upgraded facilities for pedestrians and cyclists. Key sections include:

- Phase 1: From Windsor Street to Arden Street was completed in January 2022.
- Phase 2: From Bishopton Roundabout to The Avenue, was completed in February 2025.

Work is progressing on the outbound footway from Hamlet Way to Park Road Roundabout to deliver new drainage infrastructure and upgrading the footway.

The upgrade of the outbound footway between Regal Road Roundabout and Wharf Road has been completed, along with the realignment of the additional lane on the southern approach to the roundabout to the existing kerb line. Commissioning of the new traffic signal infrastructure is scheduled for early September 2025. In the meantime, temporary pedestrian traffic signals have been installed.

Footway excavation works have begun on the outbound lane between Regal Drive and Bardwells Court. A road closure is in place on Wharf Road, however, access to the retail is being maintained.
