Warwickshire County Council hereby gives notice of its intention of proposed highway works to install (i) a traffic signal junction at Pickards Way / Development Access Road, Exhall; and (ii) a dual Toucan (pedestrian and cycle) crossing on Longford Road near Wilsons Lane, Exhall.

The proposals are required to comply with a condition attached to the planning permission for the development known as 'Land at Wilsons Lane / A444 Coventry' (Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council Planning Application Ref: OUT/2020/1505, Appeal Ref: APP/U4610/W/23/3319687).
