

## Update 27 June 2025

**Leicester Road Gyratory** – This project proposes replacing the existing Leicester Road gyratory with a new signal-controlled roundabout to enhance traffic flow around the Nuneaton ring road.

Given the scheme's sensitive location and the involvement of multiple stakeholders, the start of on-site construction will depend on detailed design development, subject to planning approval and the acquisition of necessary land.

The planning application was submitted at the end of October 2024, and the plans are now available for public consultation. A planning decision is expected by late summer or autumn 2025, with detailed design work scheduled to begin around the same time.



**Wheat Street Junction** - This scheme will transform the existing three-arm junction at Wheat Street and Vicarage Street into a new four-arm layout, improving access to Nuneaton's ring road from Bond Gate.

Key land acquisitions have been secured, and detailed design work is currently underway. The construction contract is expected to go out to tender in autumn 2025, with works anticipated to begin in winter 2025.
