

How can I apply?



You need to:

- Be 13-17 years old
- Live **AND** be educated in Warwickshire
- Submit 3 poems - one should be inspired by Warwickshire and one should be about or inspired by libraries. The third is your own choice
- Write a Personal Statement - tell us in 250 words why you want to be the Warwickshire Young Poet Laureate and how you would promote poetry to a diverse range of people

Please include your poems and personal statement along with this application form and email it to libraryevents@warwickshire.gov.uk

The closing date for applications is 6pm on Thursday 6th October 2022. Shortlisted candidates will be notified by Friday 28th October.

Shortlisted candidates will be invited to participate in a day of selection activity including a workshop with a professional poet, a short interview and a final performance in front of a public audience on **Saturday 5th November**. This event will take place in a Warwickshire Library (location to be confirmed). Please ensure you are available on this date.

Candidates will be expected not only to write poetry, but be a poetry performer and ambassador at public events.
