What is a Library Volunteer (Tabletop Games)?

A Library Volunteer (Tabletop Games) helps the Library Service with booked events and drop-in activities which involve tabletop games. These can be aimed specifically at an age group or suitable for all.

What's in it for you?

- Teaching people how to play games, and supporting them to develop their skills in language, mathematics, decision making, problem solving and strategic thinking

What's involved?

With guidance from library staff, the volunteer will:

- · Prepare the space and games for activities such as adult drop-ins and bookable events
- Meet and greet attendees
- Assist with or lead a tabletop activity
- Encourage the use of other facilities within their local library
- Promote membership of Warwickshire Library and Information Service

- Can communicate well with library staff, other volunteers and members of the public
- Are reliable, confident, supportive and enthusiastic about tabletop games
- Have good people skills, an approachable manner and patience
- Can follow guidelines and instructions to take on the duties and responsibilities of the role
- Have an understanding of health and safety
