- Promote membership of Warwickshire Library and Information Service

- Are reliable, confident, supportive and enthusiastic about crafts
- Have good people skills, an approachable manner and patience
- Can follow guidelines and instructions to take on the duties and responsibilities of the role
- Have an understanding of health and safety, both physically and mentally
