Helping young people to feel confident using public transport

Free training for young people who meet the following criteria:

- Aged 11-25 with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND)
- With an Education Health Care Plan (EHCP)
- Living in Warwickshire
- Eligible for home to school transport

What is Independent Travel Training?

- Personalised support to gain skills to travel independently using public transport
- 1:1 preparation session followed by weekly 1:1 sessions for around 9-12 weeks
- Includes journey from home to the educational provision/work placement and back

The training helps young people with:

- Personal safety
- Road safety
- Stranger awareness
- Problem solving
- Journey planning and preparation
- Coping in unexpected circumstances
- Social skills on public transport

The benefits

Independent Travel Training:

- Provides independence and life opportunities
- Builds self-esteem and confidence
- Improves access to to future learning, training and employment opportunities
- Leads to less reliance on family and friends
- Increases opportunities to participate in social and leisure activities
- Reassures parents and carers that their young person can travel safely on their own
