Park Information A handy guide





Please keep to 10mph when driving through the site. Remember pedestrians, dogs, cyclists also use the roads. Please don't leave valuables on display and ensure you have displayed your permit or ticket.



Remember you may encounter other vehicles or pedestrians. Sound your bell and keep to the left if possible, slow on approaching people and watch out for fisherman casting lines.

Environment



- Please leave all plants for others to enjoy.
- · Take your litter home help us reduce our waste costs.
- Feed the ducks, bird food is available from Visitor Centres.
- Some paths/ground can be naturally uneven, take care.

Water



Water in the lakes is untreated and lake depth can vary. Do not swim or paddle and keep off the ice in winter. Always wash your hands before you eat if you have come into contact with pond or lake water. We also advise to keep dogs out of the water.

Dogs 🎾



Dogs are welcome but keep your pet in sight and under control and do not allow your dog to approach other park users uninvited. Dogs are not permitted in play areas or bird hides. Do not allow them to chase wildlife.

Follow any signs where indicated to keep dogs on leads or out of areas.

Remember to clean up after your dog. You are required by law to do so. Dog bags are available from our Visitor Centre if you have forgotten or run out.



In an emergency

Call **999** or **101** for non emergency Police services or **111** for non emergency NHS

For first aid or non urgent matters go to the visitor centre, or find a member of staff in green uniform. If the centre is closed or the site doesn't have one, emergency numbers and locations of nearest public telephone/hospital will be displayed.

Activities are not permitted

The following activities are not permitted at Warwickshire's Country Parks:

- Unofficial camping
- Using the parks for driving tuition
- Fires, BBQs, fireworks and Chinese Lanterns
- Metal detecting
- Offroading
- Motorised play equipment (including e scooters) except mobility scooters & bicycles

- Radio controlled cars/planes
- Drones
- Unauthorised Trading
- Bouncy castles (unless agreed through events booking)
- Fishing (without valid ticket/permit)
- Swimming/paddling
- Horseriding (unless permit holder using permitted bridleways)

This list is not exhaustive, if in doubt, please contact us first don't assume its ok!
